We use a mob grazing method that allows the flock access to a single day's worth of forage. The pasture is then allowed to regenerate for the next 4-12 weeks, depending on the time of year. Hoof action on the pasture pushes manure into the soil, replenishing its nutrients and preventing carbon from entering the atmosphere. Rapidly regenerating pasture grasses draw carbon into the soil as well. We compost manure, waste hay, and dead sheep and use the finished compost to replenish soil nutrients.
